Lighting a Path from Homelessness to Hope

One of the major milestones for PorchLight in 2023 was the opening of its new permanent shelter on Eastgate Way in Bellevue. This facility provides a comprehensive range of services in a state-of-the-art environment, ensuring that men have access to safe sleeping accommodations, meals, showers, laundry, mail services, and more. This new space supports more than 100 men experiencing homelessness daily, offering a stable environment where they can rebuild their lives and transition to permanent housing.


Vincent received services in our Rotating Shelter and found the support he needed to work his way out of homelessness.




